NEW PROSPECTS:		
STYSA-South Texas Youth Soccer Assn.	Les Haulbrook	<p>Finally was able to contact the key man, Les Haulbrook. Robert Gunn and I met with him third week in February. I was invited to present our HALNet Proposal to the Bay Area Youth Soccer Association last Monday night. All clubs in the Assn. accepted. There are 12,263 players in this group; 1,934 coaches and some 7,500 households. There are 17 "clubs", (we would think of a soccer "club" as a League...a group of teams) and 1,286 teams in BAYSA. The webmaster for the association (a key coach and Assn. officer, who is in the IT department with Dow) was immediately the biggest booster for CAP. ALL of our info was on their website before 4am Tuesday morning. See www.baysa.org.</p> <p>I was put in touch with Haulbrook by the President of STYSA, South Texas Youth Soccer Association, which governs all of Southern Texas Youth Soccer South of a line thru Beaumont, Houston, Temple and El Paso I am meeting with all of the registrars for BAYSA on March 18, 2004 to instruct them in our sign-up procedure, give them forms and a HALNET placard for their Registration Tables, where a PARENT must approve the child's registraton and participation in Soccer. Each teams Registrar will be our supervisor for selling the CAP program and the Coaches and Parents club will be pushing our program. We will begin working the remainder of STYSA clubs and areas in May. There are Spring tournaments and area meetings which will give us access to the Western District of STYSA (area between Houston and San Antonio & Austin in April and May.</p>
